General Improvements and Design Changes

General Improvements include:

1. External Recipients Now Provided with Guest Account – Recipients of encrypted emails that do not have Guard, or known PGP keys, receive an auto generated guest account with a fully functioning inbox that lists their encrypted emails.
2. Download Public Keys in Contacts – Users will now be able to download public keys listed in the address book for their own use.
3. Shared Encrypted files with Other Users – When Guard is used together with Drive, users now have the ability to share encrypted files directly within the Drive web interface.
4. Key Details Available When Composing Emails – When composing an email, the source of the PGP public keys can be determined by hovering the mouse over the key icon. Additionally, the color of the key icon will change if the key is fully trusted, or if the source is questionable.
