

## TO EDIT AN A RECORD AND CNAME

Note: If we don't have instructions specific to your hosting provider, the best thing to do is to search for "edit DNS records" and the name of your hosting provider and you should find exact instructions in their support section. The instructions below are general and may not be exactly correct for your host.

1. Log in to your control panel and find your domain manager.
2. Select a domain and click either DNS or Advanced DNS Zone Editor.  
NOTE: If you only have Simple DNS Zone Editor available or don't see DNS at all, contact your provider to assist you with the changes or give us a call for help.
3. Locate your naked domain entry (example: mydomain.com or sometimes just the @ symbol) and edit to point to the first IP address provided on your TrueShield wizard.
4. Add a new A Record with @ as the host (or the naked domain ex. mydomain.com) and point it to the second IP address that was provided to you.
5. Find the CNAME record or add a new record, locate the sub domain that you would like to safeguard with TrueShield (typically "www.mydomain.com").
6. Set the record type to CNAME and enter the CNAME value that was provided to you during the setup process.
